I found this amazing little box of dominos in a red ceramic case with polka dots all over." The *Paper* editrix signed books for her friends while other guests swilled champagne and noshed on grilled cheese and lobster spring rolls.

"He is the most important designer of our times," said Chung, who worked with Beene for six years. "I met him on the Concorde," said von Furstenberg. "He loved my store on 5th Avenue so much that he ended up taking it over." **Tom Hutton**, president of Geoffrey Beene, said he had many amusing memories of Beene, but refused to dish. "I was his lawyer," he confessed, "So it's hard for me to divulge my favorite memories."
